The Cleveland Marching Band has participated in the Rose Festival Starlight Parade for eight years, and in the Grand Floral Parade in 2024. The jazz program has also continued an upward trajectory, placing 4th, 2nd, and 3rd respectively the last three years at the State Jazz Band Championships.
